BEFORE USING THIS HEATER

When using electrical appliances, basic precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons. This includes but is not limited to the following.



HOW TO USE

WARNING: The heater must only be operated in an upright position.

- To switch on the heater, turn the Power/Mode knob to the "I" or "II" position. After this, if the Power indicator is off, turn the Temperature knob clockwise until you hear a click
- To switch off the heater, turn the Power/Mode knob back to the "O" (Off) position.
- To unplug the heater, switch it off and then pull its power plug out of the electrical outlet.

I: LOW HEATING MODE, 1000W
II: HIGH HEATING MODE, 2000W

I SETTING THE TEMPERATURE

- To increase the set temperature, turn the Temperature knob clockwise.
- To decrease the set temperature, turn the Temperature knob anticlockwise.
- The heater will turn its heating element on or off to maintain the set temperature. Note: After turning off its heating element, the heater will continue radiating heat for a while because of the unique properties of its heating element. To switch off the heater, turn the Power/Mode knob back to the "0" (Off) position. To unplug the heater, switch it off and then pull its power plug out of the electrical outlet.

OVERHEAT PROTECTION

The heater is fitted with an overheat protection switch (thermal cutout) that will power off the heater automatically in case of overheating. If this occurs, follow the steps below to resolve the problem:

- Unplug the heater and allow it to cool fully.
- Check and remove the source of the overheating such as poor ventilation and item covering the heater.
- Follow the operation instructions to restart the heater.
- The heater should function normally again. If the problem persists, contact our Customer Service for advice.

| TIP-OVER PROTECTION

The heater is fitted with a tip-over switch that will cut off the power to the heater if it is tipped over. If this occurs, follow the steps below to resolve the problem:

- Unplug the heater and allow it to cool fully.
- Place the heater back on a flat, level and stable surface.
- Inspect the heater for damage.
- If and only if the heater is free from damage, follow the operation instructions to restart the heater.
