

| GENERAL INFORMATION

Please take time to carefully read and understand the entire instruction manual before using the product and then save it for future reference. I BEFORE USING THIS HEATER

When using electrical appliances, basic precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons. This includes but is not limited to the following.

CAUTION

This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge of the product. The appliance is to be operated by responsible adults only after reading and understanding these instructions. Children should be supervised at all times to ensure that they do not play with the appliance. Children under 16 years should not operate the unit or carry out maintenance and/ or clean the unit. Any infirmed persons in the vicinity of the unit should be accompanied by a responsible and competent

able bodied adult. Remove the packing and make sure that the appliance is intact. If there is any doubt concerning the integrity of the unit do not use the appliance and contact our recommended after-sales service.

Do not leave any packaging materials within easy reach of children. Before switching on appliance check if the electrical voltage and frequency of the circuit correspond to those indicated on the appliance. Use the appliance only for the stated purpose, namely as a heater for domestic use. Do not use it for any other application as it could be dangerous.

I IMPORTANT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- Children of less than 3 years should be kept away unless continuously supervised.
- Children aged from 3 years and less than 8 years shall only switch on/off the appliance provided that it has been placed or installed in its intended normal operating position and they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children aged from 3 years and less than 8 years shall not plug in, regulate

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- and clean the appliance or perform user maintenance.
- CAUTION Some parts of this product can become very hot and cause burns. Particular attention has to be given where children and vulnerable people are present.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- CAUTION: In order to avoid a hazard due to inadvertent resetting of the thermal cutout, this appliance must not be supplied through an external switching device, such as a timer, or connected to a circuit that is regularly switched on and off by the utility.
- The heater must not be located immediately below a socket-outlet.
- Means for disconnection having a contact separation in all poles must be incorporated in the fixed wiring in accordance with the wiring rules.
- For correct installation on the wall, thanks to refer to 'Installation on wall' part.
- Fixed heaters are to be installed so that switches and other controls cannot be touched by a person in the bath or shower.
- **WARNING:** In order to avoid overheating, do not cover the heater.
- Do not use this heater if it has been dropped.
- Do not use if there are visible signs of damage to the heater.
- Use this heater on a horizontal and stable surface, or install correctly and securely to a wall, as shown in this user manual.
- The heater must be installed at least 1.8m above the floor.

- **WARNING:** Do not use this heater in small rooms when they are occupied by persons not capable of leaving the room on their own, unless constant supervision is provided.
- **WARNING:** To reduce the risk of fire, keep textiles, curtains, or any other flammable material a minimum distance of 1m from the air outlet.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** Household dust, lit cigarettes, candles and oil burners, combined with the convection effect of electric heaters can cause significant soot deposits to build up on the surface directly above and to the sides of the heater. This is not a fault of the heater. Extensive burning of candles or smoking in the operating environment of this product can produce heavy discolouration within a few months of use.

Notice to Landlords, Universities, Housing Associations, Charitable Associations Or Other Similar Associations: It

is your responsibility to your Tenants where these heaters are fitted to make sure Risk Assessments are carried out for these heaters and your Tenant's are fully trained on how to operate this heater correctly and safely. 
fire, injury or even death.


If this unit is fitted in a bathroom then it should be fitted by a qualified electrician.

In the case as of buildings room, a room receiving a bath or a shower and socket-outlets lower or equal to 32 A the circuit corresponding must be protected by a device with differential residual current (RCD) lower or equal to 30 mA.




I INSTALLATION ON THE WALL











- 1. Drill holes on the wall according to the above instruction.
 - **Warning:** Be sure to keep the safety distances as shown on the above drawing.
- 2. Fit the plastic wall plugs into the drilled holes and fit the screws.
- 3. Hang the unit on the screws gently.

Warning: Before using the heater, make sure it's mounted tightly on the wall.

I HOW TO USE

• Plug the appliance into a AC 230V 50-60Hz socket and press the on/off switch located

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on the back cover, you will hear a beep sound. The power indicator light $\binom{1}{2}$ shows on.

- to turn on the heater, which is in factory default setting when used for the first time.
- Factory default:
 - · Heating mode: Comfort mode
 - Target temperature setting: 22°C
 - Window open function: Off
 - · Timer: Off

(If default settings are different, it will simply be because the unit has been quality tested after production).

- To stop the heater working, press (0) to turn off the heater, the (1) indicator will display, the heater will blow cool air for around 60 seconds to discharge heat and protect the element.
- Unplug the product when it's not in use.

TEMPERATURE SETTING

When the screen display the target set temperature, press (+) and (-) to set directly:



- - Comfort mode or Comfort mode in P1/P2/P3: Press (+) and (-) to set the temperature from 5-35 °C.
- () ECO mode or ECO mode in P1/P2/P3: Press (+) and (-) to set the temperature from 1-31 °C.

Note: ECO mode=Comfort mode - 4 °C.

CLOCK SETTING

- Press button \bigcirc for 3 seconds to enter clock and day of week setting
- The screen will display "-", press + and to select the current day from 1-7.

- (b) to confirm day setting and enter the clock hour setting, with the screen display:
- Press (+) and (-) to set the current hour from 00-23
- igoplus (igot) to confirm hour setting and enter the minute setting, with the screen display:
- Press (+) and (-) to set the current minute
- Press (b) to confirm all settings

Note: The clock and calendar will be reset to factory default if without power supply.

I FUNCTIONS SETTING EXPLAINED

Press (%) to enter mode selection. By pressing (%), heating mode runs in a continuous cycle as below:



- -o-Comfort mode: Press (+) and (-) to set the temperature from 5-35°C.
- \bigcirc ECO mode: Press \bigcirc and \bigcirc to set the temperature from 1-31°C.
- Note: ECO mode=Comfort mode 4 °C
- Anti-frost mode: the screen display . The target temperature is 7 °C. The temperature can't be adjusted
- P1/P2/P3: Pre-set heating program.

Note: If the clock and day setting are not set correctly P1/P2/P3 will not operate to the current time. it is advised to set day and clock setting in advance.

(Monday-Sunday) Pre-set program, cannot be adjusted.

SWING LOUVER FUNCTION

Press \bigcirc on the remote to turn on and off swing louver function.

SCREEN CHILD SAFETY LOCK

- To active the child lock, simply press on APP UI and then the control panel will be locked.
- To exit the child lock, press and together to unlock the control panel OR press n APP UI.

| PAT TESTING

MAINTENANCE

- 1. Always disconnect the appliance and let it completely cool before any maintenance.
- 2. Use a vacuum cleaner to remove dust on grilles.
- 3. Clean the outside of the unit with a damp cloth and then dry it with a dry cloth. Never immerse the unit in water, nor let water drip into the unit.



I STORING

- 1. Always disconnect the appliance, let it completely cool and clean it before storing.
- 2. If you do not use the device for a long period, put back the unit and the instruction manual to the original carton and store in a dry and ventilated place

Do not place any heavy items on top of carton during storing as this may damage the appliance.




